> ADVOCACY

- Pass legislation to exempt Maryland state tax on Uniformed Services' retirementincome.
 - Create legislative priorities for MD General Assembly in support of MD Military Coalition goals
 - Engage MGA bill sponsors, Committees / Subcommittees, local Delegates and Veterans Caucus on Council-supported bills via messages and testimony
- · Participate in MOAA annual Advocacy in Action (AiA) legislative campaigns
 - o Establish Council / Chapters teams to execute AiA campaign actions
- Continue in leadership roles in Maryland Military Coalition and influence its legislative agenda; participate in MMC meetings, testimony and alerts

> RECRUITMENTAND PARTICIPATION

- Exploit MOAA National resources to reach new members
- Connect with local Guard and Federal Reserve units and invite to speak at Chapter events
- Reach and sustain full Chapter participation at Council meetings and [future] Maryland Cong. Delegation receptions on Capitol Hill
- · Participate in MOAA Annual meeting, webinars / online training
- · Support Chapters in reaching and maintaining Level of Excellence (LOE) recognition
- Improve Chapter-to-Chapter communications and sharing of 'best practices' and compelling speakers
- · Participate in Transition events in Maryland and use for recruitment & brand awareness

> OUTREACH AND SOCIAL MEDIA

- Support Chapter initiatives to develop and deploy social media tools
- · Create a Council Facebook page and share content with Chapter Facebook accounts
- Test social media for community outreach & recruiting
- · Adapt MOAA National content for Chapter newsletters in print and electronic forms

> LEADERSHIP & SUCCESSION PLANNING

- Prior to leader turnover, ensure a succession plan is in place at the 1st and 2nd
 VP positions and other key positions
- · Share expertise to strengthen Chapter structure and management
- Encourage spouses to assume leadership roles in Chapter and Council activities
