Cohen Military Family Clinic at Easter Seals and the Montgomery County Chapter (MoCo) of the Military Officers Association of America (MOAA), with support from a community services outreach grant from the MOAA Foundation, will host a **Community Outreach Event on Friday, October 9, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.**

The purpose of the event is to **inform and educate the military-connected community about the behavioral healthcare services available through the Cohen Clinic** and to help ensure that veterans, service members, their families, and caregivers know where they can turn for accessible, evidence-based care.

Expanding Awareness of Available Services

The Steven A. Cohen Military Family Clinic at Easter Seals provides accessible, evidence-based behavioral healthcare to **Post-9/11 veterans, active-duty service members, their families, and caregivers.**

Services are available to people who have served in the Armed Forces, including members of the **National Guard and Reserves**, regardless of their military role or discharge status.

The Cohen Clinic uses evidence-based practices combined with a **holistic approach** designed to improve the quality of life for people with military backgrounds and their families throughout the **District of Columbia, Maryland, and Virginia region.**

"Many military-connected families may not be aware of the range of services available to them or may be uncertain about whether they qualify," said **Grace Caulfield, Vice President and Clinic Director of the Steven A. Cohen Military Family Clinic at Easter Seals.** "This outreach event is an opportunity to meet members of our

community, answer questions, and make sure that those who could benefit from our services know how to access them.”
